**CO-EXECUTORS' NOTICE TO THE COURT AND REQUEST FOR STATUS
CONFERENCE**

COME NOW the Co-Executors of the Estate of Jeffrey E. Epstein (the "Estate"),
DARREN K. INDYKE & RICHARD D. KAHN, and hereby notify the Court as follows:

The Co-Executors of the Estate of Jeffery E. Epstein and the Attorney General of the Virgin Islands continue to work together to implement the Epstein Victims' Compensation Program, which is designed to provide a respectful, non-adversarial alternative to litigation for any person who suffered sexual abuse by Mr. Epstein. On Thursday, March 5, 2020, counsel for the Co-Executors met with representatives of the Attorney General, claimants' counsel, and the Program's Administrator and Designers to discuss areas of continued mutual concern. While the Co-Executors and the Attorney General have made progress, several issues of critical importance to the Program's funding, structure and function remain unresolved.

The Estate and the Attorney's General's Office also have been unable to reach agreement regarding the need for further funding to administer the Estate.

The Co-Executors, therefore, ask the Court to schedule a status conference during the week of March 9, 2020 with counsel for the parties to resolve any remaining differences, so that the estate can continue to function and the Program can become a reality. The Co-Executors also request that their off-island counsel be permitted to attend through video conferencing, or alternatively, by telephone.


