PURSUANT TO Admin Order. No. 2020-0001 of the Supreme Court the following modified schedule will be implemented as of Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at 5:00 p.m., until further notice. It is hereby

ORDERED that Advice of Rights will only take place on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday at 9:00 a.m. It is further

ORDERED that **Arraignments** will proceed as normally scheduled. It is further

ORDERED that **Stalking and Domestic Violence** shall be scheduled for Mondays. Case scheduled times must be staggered to avoid no more than 10 people at any given time. No more than 5 cases should be scheduled at one time. It is further

ORDERED that **Traffic and Small Claims** cases are suspended until further notice. It is further

ORDERED that **Bench Trials** will proceed as scheduled by the Judicial Officers. Case scheduled times must be staggered to avoid no more than 10 people at any given time. No more than 5 cases should be scheduled at one time. It is further

ORDERED that **Judicial Officers** use their discretion and only schedule hearings that are emergencies or time sensitive in nature. Cases must be staggered to avoid no more than 20 people at any given time. It is further


ORDERED that **Telephonic hearings** shall be utilized when possible. It is further
